Rear Trailing Arm to Hub Bush

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Contents (parts per pack):

- 4 x Polyurethane Insert Bush
- 2 x Stainless Steel Sleeve
- 1 x PTFE/Silicone Grease

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- -All fasteners must be tightened to manufacturer's torque settings.



Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Support the weight of the rear hub and remove the bolt from the trailing arm.
- 2. Remove the original bush including its outer shell from the hub assembly.
- 3. Clean away any dirt and corrosion, removing any sharp edges or burrs with a rounded file and fit the polyurethané bushes into either of the hub eyelet.
- 4. Apply some of the supplied grease to the bore of the bush and press in the stainless steel sleeve.
- 5. Bolt the trailing arm back into position and re-assemble with the original washer placed as shown in Fig. 1.
- 6. Tighten all hardware to the manufacturers recommended torque settings.
