FRONT LOWER RADIUS ARM TO CHASSIS **BUSH**

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Contents (parts per pack):

2 x Polyurethane A Bushes 1 x PTFE/Silicone Grease

2 x Stainless Steel Sleeves 4 x Zinc Plated Mild Steel Washers

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any
- -All fasteners must be tightened to manufacturer's torque settings.

Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Remove the front lower radius arm from the car.
- Press the standard rubber bush from the radius 2. arm.
- 3. Clean the bore of the arm and file away any sharp edges or burrs.
- 4. Using some soap or washing up liquid as a lubricant, press the polyurethane bush into the arm.
- 5. Apply a generous amount of the supplied grease to the knurled bore of the polyurethane bush.
- Press the stainless steel sleeve into the bush. 6.
- 7. Using any excess grease to hold them in place, stick a washer to each end of the bush.
- 8. Refit the arm to the vehicle, and tighten all hardware to manufacturer's recommended torque settings.






Figure 1: Assemble with washers
