## **Rear Lower Spring Seat Isolator**

## **INSTALLATION GUIDE**

## Contents (parts per pack):

2 x Powerflex PFR85-1330 Spring Pads

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- -All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

## **Fitting Instructions:**

- 1. Raise the vehicle on a workshop lift or with a trolley jack and support on axle stands.
- 2. Remove the rear wheels to gain access to the rear arms.
- 3. Support the rear arms from underneath with a jack or transmission stand and remove the lower shock absorber bolt.
- 4. Lower the rear arm so that the spring can decompress and be removed, along with the rubber spring isolator.
- 5. Clean the arm and the spring of any dirt and
- 6. Place the Powerflex spring isolator over the spigot of the arm.
- 7. Place the spring back into position and raise the arm until seated correctly in both the upper and lower positions.
- 8. Refit the lower shock absorber bolt, tensioning all hardware to the manufacturer's recommended torque settings
